# **ZOOLOGICAL HOLDING QUARTERLY MORTALITY REPORT**

Quarterly reports must be submitted each year on a quarterly basis - EVERY THREE MONTHS. THESE REPORTS ARE REQUIRED FOR THE ZOOLOGICAL HOLDING PERMIT AND MUST BE SUBMITTED EVEN IF NO CHANGES OCCUR (indicating no changes).

These MUST BE SUBMITTED QUARTERLY. MANDATORY DUE DATES ARE:

MARCH 31<sup>ST</sup>

JUNE 30<sup>TH</sup>

SEPTEMBER 30<sup>TH</sup>

\*DECEMBER 31<sup>ST</sup> \*(only this report should be submitted with the annual Zoological Holding renewal application/annual report). All others should be sent by mandatory due dates – quarterly, as indicated above.

IMPORTANT NOTE: NO ADDITIONAL POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS SPECIES OF ANY KIND MAY BE OBTAINED WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE WILDLIFE PERMITS UNIT, EXOTIC AND NONGAME WILDLIFE SECTION. Request for approval must be in writing and include information on the proposed Potentially Dangerous species.

A written description (plans on new facilities) for housing of Potentially Dangerous Species requires prior approval and must be submitted prior to construction.



## **IMPORTANT NOTE**

Report any large scale deaths in your collection and any undiagnosed mortalities. **Regarding all Cervidae - Notify the above office immediately (within 24 hours)** of any deaths characterized by emaciation. If **Chronic Wasting Disease** is suspected, preserve the retropharyngeal lymph nodes by removing the head and preserving by refrigeration (**not freezing**).
