

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-1727

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 505.01 (c) AND 505.074 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELL, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Codified Ordinances of the City of Campbell Section 505.01 (c) shall hereby be amended to remove the words "tether" and "leash".

SECTION 2. That all of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Campbell Section 505.074, as now stated shall be deleted, and replaced with the following:

505.074

(1). Tethering. Tethering means that an animal is tied with a rope, chain or other device so as to restrict the animal's movement.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any animal to be tethered.

(b) Whoever violates this this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree. In addition, the court may order the offender to forfeit the animal or livestock and may provide for its disposition. If an animal or livestock is forfeited, the expenses incurred with regard to the care of the animal from the time it was taken from the custody of the former owner until the disposition of the court case, shall be paid by the former owner.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
